

PRIVACY POLICY

Effective date: 12 August 2026

1. Introduction

This Privacy Policy describes how personal data are processed in connection with the use of the web application “**CZECH AND MORAVIAN PARACHUTING CUPS**” on the web pages <https://cmpp.cz/> (the “Application” or “App”) for athlete registration, administration of sports competitions and processing of competition results.

The application serves as a technical tool for the organising aeroclubs. The aeroclub organising a particular competition acts as the controller of the personal data of athletes registered for that competition.

The operator of the application provides the technical processing of personal data within the scope and in accordance with the instructions of the relevant organising aeroclub.

2. Data Controller

The **organising aeroclub** of the particular competition is the controller of the personal data processed in connection with that competition.

The identification details of the controller and the relevant contact person are provided in the regulations of the particular competition.

Regulations of the particular competition are published on the website of the Aeroclub of the Czech Republic (<https://www.aeroklub.cz/>) or on the App's website.

The organising aeroclub may use the operator of the application as a processor for the technical processing of personal data.

3. Personal Data Processed

In connection with registration and participation in a competition, the following personal data may be processed:

- first name and surname,
- year of birth,
- sex,
- country,
- affiliation with an aeroclub,
- information provided during registration for a particular competition, including licence type, number of jumps and canopy type,
- information concerning checks of mandatory documents and requirements related to participation,

- information related to registration and payments for entry fees, meals, accommodation and other competition-related services, where such information is recorded in the application,
- sporting information and competition results.

An athlete's contact details, in particular a telephone number or e-mail address, may be processed in connection with a particular registration if provided by the athlete or team captain.

Contact details of the organiser may be recorded in the application for communication with athletes. Such details are normally public contact details already published in the regulations of the relevant competition.

Year of birth

The registration form requests **the year of birth only**.

The year of birth is used primarily to determine the appropriate age category of the athlete.

If an athlete nevertheless voluntarily enters their complete date of birth in the form, this information may technically be stored in the database. Such a date is not used for any purpose other than the purposes for which the year of birth is used.

4. Purposes of Processing

Personal data are processed in particular for the following purposes:

- registration of athletes for a particular competition,
- administration of participation in the competition,
- verification of eligibility requirements,
- determination of the relevant sporting and age category,
- administration of the competition,
- processing and recording of competition results,
- maintaining an athlete database for future competitions,
- communication relating to registration and organisation of the competition,
- processing of payments and related records where such information is maintained in the application,
- publication of official sporting results to the extent appropriate to the nature and rules of the competition.

Information from previous competitions may be used when registering for a subsequent competition so that the athlete does not have to enter the same information again. At every new registration, the information is reviewed and confirmed or updated.

The transfer of information from a previous registration does not constitute automatic registration for a new competition. A new registration and confirmation of the current information are required for each new participation.

5. Competition Registration

An athlete is registered for a particular competition at the athlete's request by means of a registration form.

In a team competition, the registration form is signed by the team captain, who confirms the correctness of the information and compliance with the applicable participation requirements of the team members to the extent stated in the registration form.

Information submitted through the web form may be used for the sole purpose of generating and sending the registration:

- to the organising aeroclub,
- to the designated application administrators,
- to the athlete or team captain as a copy.

An athlete's or team captain's e-mail address provided in the form may be used for sending the registration confirmation or a copy of the registration and is not permanently stored in the athlete database unless there is another specific purpose for retaining it.

6. Access to Personal Data

Access to personal data stored in the non-public part of the application is restricted to persons expressly authorised to administer the application.

At present, this consists of five designated administrators.

The organising aeroclubs jointly use the application through this administrative mechanism. Access to personal data is limited to what is necessary for the administration of competitions.

The general public does not have access to the non-public database.

7. Published Information

Following a competition, official sporting results may be published.

The scope of published information corresponds to the nature of the competition and the applicable rules governing the publication of results. Published information may include, in particular, the athlete's first name and surname, team, sporting result and ranking.

The athlete's year of birth, date of birth, telephone number and non-public e-mail address are not included in the public results.

8. Retention of Personal Data

Athlete information remains in the database after a particular competition because the application serves as a shared athlete database for repeated competitions.

When registering for a subsequent competition, the information is reviewed again and the athlete or team captain may request that it be corrected or updated.

Personal data are retained until the athlete requests their deletion, unless continued retention of particular information is necessary because of a legal obligation, legitimate interest, preservation of official results or another legal basis permitting or requiring further retention.

A request for deletion may be submitted to the organising aeroclub or to the contact person specified in the regulations of the relevant competition.

9. Use of Information by Different Organising Aeroclubs

The athlete database is jointly used by the organising aeroclubs participating in the use of the application.

Information from a previous competition may be used when an athlete registers for a subsequent competition organised by another aeroclub, solely in connection with the athlete's new registration and for the purpose of facilitating that registration.

The information is reviewed and confirmed or corrected during each new registration.

10. Rights of Data Subjects

Under applicable data protection legislation, data subjects have, in particular, the right to:

- request access to their personal data,
- request correction of inaccurate or incomplete data,
- request deletion of personal data where the conditions under the GDPR are met,
- request restriction of processing,
- object to processing based on legitimate interests,
- request data portability where the conditions under the GDPR are met,
- lodge a complaint with the competent supervisory authority.

In the Czech Republic, the supervisory authority is the **Office for Personal Data Protection (Úřad pro ochranu osobních údajů)**.

Requests or questions concerning personal data may be submitted to the organising aeroclub or to the contact person specified in the regulations of the relevant competition.

11. Security of Personal Data

Personal data are protected by appropriate technical and organisational measures corresponding to the nature of the data being processed.

Access to the non-public part of the application is restricted to designated administrators.

Personal data are not made available to the public except for information intended to be published as part of official competition results or other public competition information.

12. Cookies and Technical Data

The application does not maintain a separate record of visitors' personal data through IP addresses, login history, device or browser identifiers or similar tracking information.

The application does not maintain a database of such information for the purpose of tracking users.

13. Changes to this Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy may be updated, in particular, if there is a change in applicable legislation, the operation of the application or the scope of personal data processed.

The current version is published on the application's website.

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
